specifically for our Priests. Our Priests are leaders in our army who have been chosen for the most important task of leading the Faithful to Heaven. They are chosen by God Himself to be His means of delivering to us that most valuable commodity called *Sanctifying Grace*.

We want that *Sanctifying Grace*! Since we are creatures - that is, we are *creations* - everything we have has been given to us by the One who made us. If we want to give anything back to Him, we find we can only give what we have been given. We would think that it is spiritual things that we can give to Him - but even our virtues - those holy habits would not be here with us if He hadn't prompted them within us and sustained us in keeping them. Thus, we have nothing in and of ourselves that God truly wants. That's why we need that *Sanctifying Grace*. It is another gift He gives to us - but THIS is the very gift of *being* desirable to Him. When our soul is filled with Sanctifying Grace, He sees that in us and has a great desire for unity with us because we possess that Grace. It's kind of like a catch-22, but for our benefit: we are undesirable, so He gives us the gift of being desirable and then He desires us! This Sanctifying Grace is the most valuable thing in our life and we need to do all we can to possess it and keep it. And since we only get Sanctifying Grace via the Sacraments, we have to do all we can to preserve our means of getting it - hence our devotion to the priests who deliver the Sacraments in His name!

And here you are, Crusaders, a holy army devoted to the preservation of our means of Sanctifying Grace. Every day, you pray for all priests in general and for a particular one (or more) that they are kept safe and holy. As we pass en masse through this Valley of Tears, you Crusaders form a sort of Honour Guard - a cohort of spiritual bodyguards for those beloved captains and leaders of ours.

Crusader, keep Crusading. God sees your daily devotion and He knows how you pray for our priests. He will bless each of you individually, and He will bless all of us together as he regards our unity and purpose.

- 📌 There are presently 1664 Crusaders (in the last letter #15, of July 2019, we reported 1584 Crusaders).
- 📌 We pray for 949 priests, 85 of whom are deceased.
- 📌 Here is a list of priests who have died since our last Newsletter; if we each say a little prayer for them, that makes 1664 prayers apiece which they would not have had without us!
 - Father Paul Aulagnier, SSPX who died on May 6, 2021
 - Brother Gabriel, SSPX (*not me* - the other one) who died in Ecône on December 22, 2020 at age 79.
 - Father Walter Ranger, SSPX who died on August 31, 2020
- 📌 Please also pray for the soul of Jon Rydholm. He was the husband of Kathy Rydholm who is the Secretary at Regina Coeli House and my assistant in the Prayer Crusade for Priests.
- 📌 Also remember our priests who have been diagnosed with or are suffering from Coronavirus.
